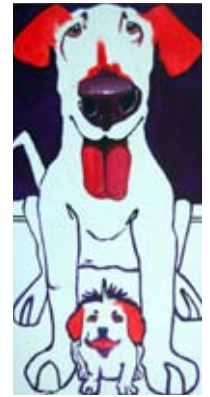
Discover new things about "America's Favorite Animal Artist"
